## VERSE 1:

You [Am] know ~ , if you [C//] break my [G6//] heart I'll [F] go  
But [E7] I'll be back a-[A]gain Riff [A]  
Cause [Am] I ~ , told you [C//] once be-[G6//]fore good-[F]bye  
But [E7] I came back a-[A]gain Riff

## BRIDGE 1: REF

[A] . . I love you so.. [F#m] oh ~ [F#m] I'm the one who  
[Bm] wants you, - - [Bm] yes I'm the one who  
[E7//] wants you [D//] Oh - [E7//] - ho [D//] Oh-ho [E7//] Oh

## VERSE 2:

[Am] you ~ , could find [C//] better [G6//] things to [F] do  
Than to [E7] break my heart a-[A]gain Riff [A]  
This [Am] time ~ , I will [C//] try to [G6//] show that  
[F] I'm,~~ not [E7] trying to pre-[A]tend Riff [A]

## BRIDGE 2:

[Bm] I ~~~~[Bm]~ thought that you would [C#m] realize, -[C#m]  
- - that if I [F#m] ran away from you  
That [B7] you would want me too,  
but [Bm] I got a big  
sur-[E7//]prise [D//] Oh - [E7//] - ho [D//] Oh-ho [E7//] Oh

## VERSE 3:


[Am] you ~ , could find [C//] better [G6//] things to [F] do
