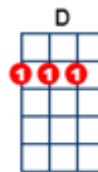

Roll over Bee--- thoven an' Tell Tchai-kovsky the news-----

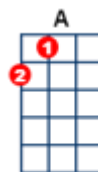


VERSE 3 : -----
